Minutes from the February meeting were read and approved- Lydia 1st, Pam 2nd, all were in favor

The treasurer's report was submitted and approved- Lydia 1st, Misty 2nd, all were in favor. Pam handed out 2015 expenditures and earnings for the club. There is a concern about our club not breaking even with the amount of money they take in and what we are spending each year.

Saxon Graham with the Switchbacks was present for the meeting and did a presentation a partnership between the Switchbacks and with Canon City Blitz. There are different options with prices that he will send the club. The club presented our ideas; attending switchback games, player development, training opportunities for coaches, training or goalkeepers and recruiting more players. He discussed part of the partnership is bringing players to games, wanting to continue to help grow the game of soccer and be good community partners.
