The May meeting minutes were presented by Lydia and were reviewed. Misty made a motion to approve and Lisa seconded it.

The June meeting minutes were reviewed. Lydia made a motion to approve and Pam seconded it.

The referee Assignor was not present, so there weren't any updates.

Lydia said there is a new referee uniform and some new laws of the game. Coaches and ref's will be advised. We should be able to continue using the old uniforms for now, because we just got some of the older style recently.

The treasurer's report was provided. \$1390.00 was deposited for Fall player deposit fees. \$835.30 was paid out to coaches, field prep, storage fees and advertising. Our ending balance is \$9,471.74.

Nobody from the public was present.

Lisa will reach out to CSA regarding rescheduling the E license class in August before opening weekend.

Fall registration was discussed and an up to date list of those players that are currently registered was handed out. It was voted to have a U13 girls team, so all of the girls can play and not be split up. Lydia made a motion and Misty seconded it. There are 5 girls with 2004 dates of birth. One is a 7th grader and will play with the U15 girls and the other 3 are going into 6th grade and will play with the U13 girls. A U12 team would have resulted in girls not being able to play. There was one incoming 4th grader that will be refunded her \$50 deposit due to such a big age spread for that age group and the availability for rec soccer still and the U13's will now be playing 11v11.

At this time, Jeanenne Wagner volunteered to Coach the HS girls, but she is in need of an Assistant Coach. U15 girls will be coached by Lisa Rowe and Assistant Coach will be Matt Wimmer(limited availability) and U13 girls will be coached by Lisa Rowe and Assistant Coach will be Amy Richardson. Trevor Ford and Alex Johnson will continue to coach the U15 boys. We are still looking for coaches, if anyone is interested or knows of anyone.

There was a discussion about our current scholarship. Lydia made a motion and Pam approved for the scholarship to remain the same with adding a line to disclose income and that documentation may be requested by the board. Scholarships need to be need/income based and only one scholarship per

family. Scholarships will not be given solely on having a sibling playing on another team. There is a \$10 discount for a sibling player.

The U15 boys will have to either play in a Metro League or a Mountain League. Lydia and Misty are having a U15 boys meeting and this will be decided. This is an issue all over the state and will be an issue in the Spring for the U15 girls as well.

Uniform information should go out next week. New Under Armour uniforms were approved in the winter. The board has made an effort to have less costly uniforms and a uniform style that will last 2-3 years. Uniforms will have a gold away jersey, a home black jersey and black shorts that will not include a number and black socks.

We are going to try and reach out to other clubs to try and sell our small sided goals since we have no 9v9 teams at this time. We'll start with advertising them to other clubs and then go from there.

The fall fundraiser for the whole Blitz club was tabled until the August meeting for Kyle to update the group on.
