Minutes from the June meeting were presented by Lydia read and approved- Kyle 1st, Lynn 2nd.

The Treasurers report was submitted and explained- Lydia 1st Kyle 2nd, all were in favor. The bank account and PO Box have been updated.

There were updates on each of the teams as they stand now for the Fall Season regarding numbers of players registered. Current teams filled are U10, U11 and U13 girls, HS girls and U12 boys. The U12 boys team has 1 player too many- it was discussed whether to break that team up or leave it large. Kristy Cushman also indicated there might be a few other HS girls interested in playing.

There was talk about what do with the U15 boys and girls teams. There are 13 U15 boys registered and 8 U15 girls registered. Some options include; a HS girls try out and would include the U15 girls, the Front Range Leagues or the Mountain Leagues for the boys. Combining the U15 boys/girls to play in the Pueblo co-ed Middle school league. A decision needs to be made no later than July 24th. It was decided that everyone would work on recruiting a few more players for the U15 boys and creating a U16 girls team with the HS freshman playing with the U15 girls to make 2 teams. Kristy and Jeanenne didn't want to have to cut girls from the program.

Lydia reminded everyone of the upcoming E license clinics; this is the last chance to use grant funds.

Practice schedules were submitted by the coaches and the ones that aren't sure will get with Lydia. Also discussed were equipment needs.

Lydia let the coaches know that she's going to work on getting a goalie clinic for interested players once or twice/month.
