September 18, 2017 meeting minutes: Submitted by Lydia Beals & Lisa Rowe.

The meeting began at approximately 7:05 p.m.

Tino Leone Coach, Eddie Basham Coach, and Thom LeDoux Coach were also present.

Referee Assignor business was discussed. A local class for Grade 8 & 9 was offered and we had 11 referees in attendance. Lydia will purchase referee uniform kits for all of the referees in attendance. The referees paid for the course themselves.

Minutes from the August meeting were presented by Lydia read and approved- Lori 1st, Lynn 2nd, all were in favor with no changes.

The Treasurers report was submitted and explained, 1 correction was made, and then it was motioned to be approved- Lydia 1st Lori 2nd, all were in favor. Lynn will ensure that all players from the fall season have paid their fees in full by talking with the managers.

Coaches asked about getting a second set of small sided goals. The board approved purchasing a second set of goals through Fold-a-Goal as these will be cheaper than going through soccer.com and using a limited grant from CSA. Lydia will ensure that all teams approve having the second set of goals placed on the North field with anchors. Lydia will order the goals and all equipment needed.

The U11 and U10 coaches also asked about concerns with the FRL rules. They would like clarification from CSA in regards to the field size, referee requirements, and roster rules. They have played games on larger fields with only 1 referee. They have also seen teams add players to their roster from a team who played prior to their game. Lydia will contact Jimmy Sparkman from CSA and then get back to these teams coaches with answers. The U11 team may prefer to play in the Centennial league for the spring season to avoid some of these issues; they also feel they need a higher level of competition for their team. The U10 girls will also need to play at a higher level in the FRL for the spring in order to have more competition.

Lydia has found 2 potential field liners for the club. Bruce Smith will train both people to do the job. Trenton Perdue and Joe Alvarado will both be paid \$10/ hour to complete this job as needed at the fields. Trenton will be hired to do the job and Joe will serve as a back up or assistant as he is a high school senior and not a long term option.

Lydia has been told by parents that goalkeeper practice is going well. The club seems to be benefitting from this added service. We are currently offering goalkeeper training twice a month to the entire club.

November is election month for the board. It was discussed and noted that the Vice President and 2 At-Large positions are all up for re-election. Sergei reported to the group that he is unsure if he wants to remain on the board at this time. Lisa offered to check in with Kyle West as he was not at the meeting and up for re-election. Lydia will reach out to the club to find out if anyone is interested in joining the board. Lydia will also talk to JJ Johns to find out if he would like to remain on the board. The board also discussed the importance of adding duties to our At-Large positions. The board believes it would be valuable to have members who focus on community outreach, equipment, or fundraising for the club.

The board closed for an executive session on a scholarship application.

The meeting was adjourned 8:35pm; the next meeting is scheduled for November 6th at 7 pm.
